For thousands of years, people have travelled the beautiful waterway of the Wisconsin River. Often referred to as "The hardest working river in the world", the Wisconsin River flows through 430 miles of the state of Wisconsin. The stretch of river near the quaint town of Spring Green is beautifully dominated by sandbars, islands and high river bluffs which have inspired paddlers for years.



Our group will take two days to explore this scenic waterway. Paddling down this lazy stretch of river, we will allow ample time to relax on sandbars and explore nearby bluffs. Wildlife we may see include great blue heron, bald and golden eagles, sandhill cranes, deer and an abundance of small river mammals including otter and beaver. We plan this trip to take advantage of the fall colors, and hope to paddle surrounded by the bright hues of Wisconsin's incredible autumn. After an exciting day on the water we will relax at our campsite and enjoy a hearty meal around a fire.

Continuing our journey the next morning we will paddle to the small town of Spring Green where we will land the kayaks by mid afternoon, and head back to our respective homes.
